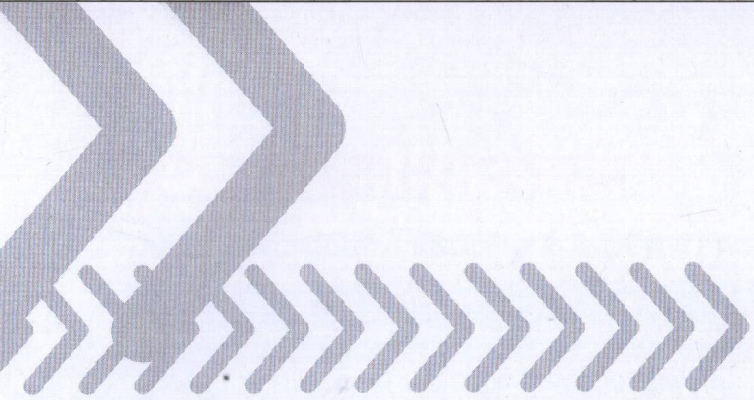
## SPECIAL FEATURES OF THE SCHOOL

1. The school prepares students for appearing Primary / Secondary School Examinations.
2. The school provides all the ultra-modern facilities to enable the students learn well and face the challenges of the competitive world.
3. The school inculcates in the students an awareness of their traditionally rich cultural heritage and infuses in them the culture of living in harmony with natural environment.
4. The school arranges outdoor training programs to generate the confidence and dynamism in the personality of the students to face the challenges of competitive life.
5. The school organizes morning assembly and prayer before conducting the regular classes daily. In its morning assembly, the school imparts News, Speech, thought for the Day, Quiz and Moral teaching on ethical values.
6. The school organizes Inter House Co - curricular activities by conducting competitions among the students in Elocution, Debate, Essay Writing, Quiz, Drawing and Painting and Dance and Music. # GENERAL RULES OF THE SCHOOL



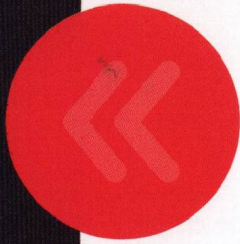
1. The students should arrive at the school only around five minutes before the call bell is rung.
2. Clean and prescribed school uniform is to be worn on all the school days. A student not following the same may be sent home.
3. The students must carry with them their School Diary while entering the class, library etc.
4. Any photograph to be attested by the authority of the school must be snapped in the school uniform only.
5. All students must reach assembly area with utmost discipline along with their respective class teachers. After assembly they must return back in the same way to their classrooms.
6. All students are guided to keep their classroom and surrounding clean and tidy.
7. The students are not allowed to bring any kind of valuables like cell phones, iPods, MP3/4 Players, Camera, Transistors, Precious coins, Stones or any other jewellery items like chain, earrings etc. to the school. The school will not be responsible for loss of any such items if brought by the students. Rather such items will be seized by the authority of the school if found in the school premises.
8. Indiscipline among the students will not be accepted at any cost rather the same will be viewed very seriously. Action will be taken deem fit for the situation.
9. Irregular attendance, habitual late arrival, idleness, negligence of homework, disobedience and disrespect towards teachers and others may entail dismissal from the school.
10. Every student must participate in co- curricular activities unless declared unfit or exempted by organizers.
11. Students and parents are advised to park their mode of transport in the parking space allotted to them on their own risk.
12. No vehicle should enter into the school premises without the permission of the competent authority.
13. Students are not allowed to call their parents or anybody without the permission of their class teacher in the school hours.
14. Extra unnecessary books, journals, magazines etc. must not be brought by the students without the prior permission of the authority.
15. Students must not lend, borrow any amount of money among the peers. No collection for any purpose, whatsoever shall be made in the school without the permission of the authority.
16. All the students are supposed to extend cooperation in maintaining the property of the school, like
  - i. Not to spoil or scratch the benches, chairs or desks at any cost.
  - ii. Damage done to any furniture of the school should be reported to the class teacher. Class teacher must inform the same to the authority. Recovery against such damage must be done by the concerned student(s) together with a fine imposed on him/her/them for such a misdeed.



iii. No student should write or spoil the walls of the classroom or any other.

17. Students must be accompanied by their proper guardians, in case of late must be intimated to the office for further information.
18. Students must not bring oily food and pickles to the school in their Tiffin.
19. Students are advised to avoid buying unhygienic eatables.
20. The school reserves the right to dismiss such students whose diligence of progress in studies is constant or appears to be non-progressive in spite of the teachers' efforts and individual attention. Unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to the school environment or those guardians show little interest in the progress of their wards.
21. The students who commute by the school buses should wait at their respective bus stop in an orderly manner and board the bus in a disciplined manner. They should not board or alight from a moving bus. The students who come to school by cycle , they should park their cycle in the cycle stand and lock it properly and carefully.
22. Students should behave in a gentle manner wherever they go. They should remember that the school is judged by their conduct.
23. They should greet their seniors, teachers and all elders with respect whenever and wherever they meet them.
24. Fire crackers or splashing colours in school premises is strictly prohibited. Such activities may result in expulsion from the school.
25. No child is permitted to leave the school campus without the prior and proper permission of the Principal. Such permission will be granted only on the specific request of the parents in writing that to only on special ground. Principal's decision is final and binding.
26. Every student must cover his/her note book/ text book properly in prescribed covers only and label them positively.
27. Unauthorized photography is not allowed in the school. Permission for the same must be obtained from the Principal.
28. No student is allowed to wear fashionable articles or clothes in the normal school days but that are allowed only on certain functions under the guidance of teachers.
29. Spoken English must be a challenge for every student of this school; they must speak English in and around the school.
30. The students must participate in all school activities with full zest and zeal.
31. Student's diary must be read and completed in all respects within the seven days after receiving it.

# RULES CONCERNING ABSENCE



1. Leave is granted only on written request in the form of an application submitted by the Parents/Guardian, well in advance (except exceptional cases). The leave granted on genuinely. More than one day's sick leave must be accompanied with a medical certificate. Not more than three days leave may be granted at a time in one month if the month has working days in full.
2. Leave for the half day or only one day can be processed through the school diary, duly signed by the parents/guardian. Leave for more than one day must be processed in the form of an application submitted by the parent /guardian.
3. Half day leave is granted on emergency ground only with proper documentation/any unexpected suffering of the child.
4. Willful absence will be dealt seriously. Absence for seven consecutive days without approval of the Principal would lead to cancellation of admission and the child will not be allowed to attend classes. Readmission in such cases will be the sole discretion of the Principal.
5. If a student suffering from any infectious disease wishes to resume classes after recovery, must tender fitness certificate from a authorized Physician .Students suffering from any of the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class.



- a. **Chicken pox** - Till falling of scabs completely
  - b. **Cholera** - Till the recovers completely
  - c. **Measles** - Two weeks after the rash disappears
  - d. **Mumps** - Until the swelling reduces ( 3 to 4 weeks)
  - e. **Whooping cough** - Six weeks
  - f. **Conjunctivitis** - Till the child recovers completely
6. Rest information will be intimated with the progress of school proceedings.

- N.B**
1. Black and White hair band for girls is allowed as per the described dates but no coloured hair bands are allowed.
  2. Whenever a student visits the school for whatsoever the reason may be, he / she must be in school uniform.
  3. Disrespect to the uniform will be viewed seriously.
  4. The frames of the spectacles should either brown or black or metallic's. No coloured or designed frames are allowed in the school.

## COLLECTION OF FEES

1. The fees for each month must be deposited in the designated bank on or before 15th day of every month. Parents are requested to deposit the fees as per the schedule to avoid extra payment of late fees which is charged @ Rs. 10 /-(Ten Rupees Only) per month, if the amount is not deposited on the due date and in time .In case the 15th day appears to be an off day, the fees will be collected on the next working day.
2. If a child's name remains on the fee defaulters' list for two consecutive months, his/ her name gets struck off the rolls. Re - admission of such a child is done only after the payment of the outstanding dues, with fine.
3. The School Management reserves the right to revise the fees. Apart from the school fees, as determined by the school authorities, students will be required to pay for excursion, educational tour and adventure sports as and when organized by the school.

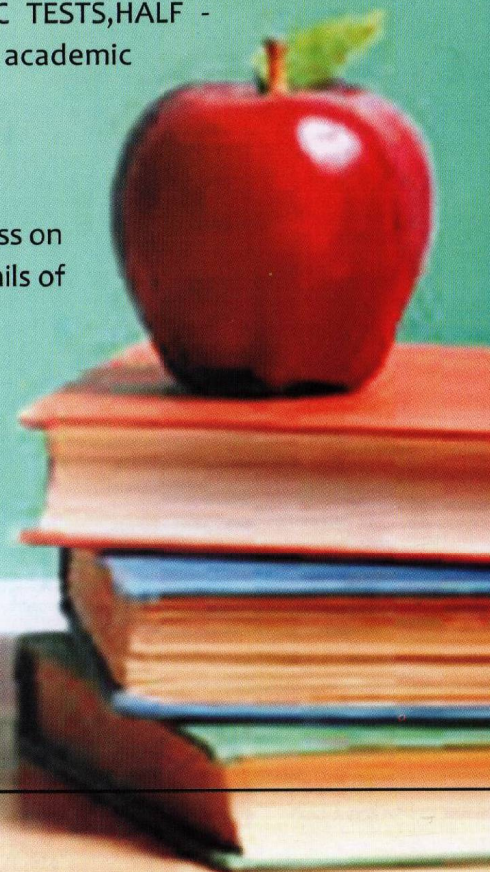
## BUS FACILITY

Bus facility is provided subject to the availability of seats and bus pass on first cum first serve basis. The routes are subject to change and school reserves all the rights in this regard. The students will be picked up and dropped at the approved bus stoppages only. The students possessing bus pass will only be allowed to avail the facility. In case , a student wishes to stop availing the bus facility , he / she has to give one month notice or has to pay one month 's bus fees in lieu, thereof. Once a student withdraws the facility, the same cannot be revived in the same academic session. Anybody found deviating from the above rules strict action may be taken against the concerned.



## ACADEMIC

1. **Session** - The academic session starts from March / April and ends on March / April of the next year.
2. **Examination** - The school conducts various assessments (PERIODIC TESTS, HALF - YEARLY, ANNUAL, PRE- BOARD, VST) at regular intervals for the academic achievements of the students as per CBSE norms.
3. **Promotion Criteria** -
  - a. For classes LKG - II  
The students will be assessed and promoted to the next higher class on the basis of the Continuous & Comprehensive Evaluation. The details of the CCE are to be provided at the time of Orientation Program.
  - b. For classes III - V
    - i. No academic rank will be awarded.
    - ii. Promotion to the next higher class is granted on review of the overall performance of the students through PERIODIC & OTHER TESTS in the whole academic year as per the guidance of CBSE.
    - iii. For classes VI - X  
Promotion will be based on the Cumulative Assessment. Further class VIII and X will face DAV Board and CBSE BOARD examinations respectively and class IX will face Internal Board Examination.



# ATTENDANCE

1. It is compulsory for every student to complete at least 75% attendance in an academic year in order to make him/her eligible to appear in his/her final examination. Leave on account of illness etc. is also considered as absence for this purpose and no relaxation is granted in such cases.
2. Attendance is compulsory on the following days (In addition to the regular classes)
  - a. Independence Day
  - b. Republic Day
  - c. Annual Function and Prize distribution Day
  - d. Annual Sports Meet
  - e. Any important day decided by the school
  - f. Reopening Day

N.B- No leave will be granted on these above days and action will be taken against the defaulter.

In order to infuse an all round development of personality in the students, the school organizes wide range of co-curricular activities as stated below:-

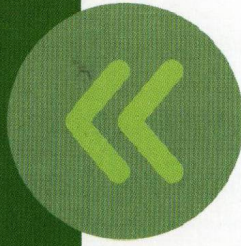

## PARENT'S ROLE



1. Read the instructions published in the school diary.
2. Label all the belongings of their ward with his / her name , especially , the sweaters, uniforms, blazers, Tiffin boxes, water bottles, pencil boxes etc.
3. Check the school diary every day and ensure that the ward has done the assigned home worker notices given on any basis.
4. Prohibit the students from carrying valuable items to school like cell phones, gold ornaments, electronic gadgets, calculators, toys, scissors etc. to the school.
5. Encourage their children to speak in English during and beyond the school hours too, as the medium of instructions in the school is English.
6. Leave their children undisturbed by not taking them away during the working days of the school and school hours.
7. Communicate suggestion to the teachers regarding their wards performance/ conduct through his/her school diary or during Parent Teachers Meeting.
8. Refrain from interfering with the school administration in any manner. In case of any problem, they can discuss the matter with the Principal during the visiting hours, or at any other time with prior intimation.
9. Check hair-cut, uniform, handkerchief, bags, etc. of their ward before they send them to the school.
10. Avoid meeting the Teachers / Students during the school hours without the prior permission of the Principal.
11. Refrain from persuading the teachers to hold private tuitions, for their children. It may be noted that no teacher of our school is permitted to hold private tuitions in any manner.
12. Instruct their representative escorting their wards to park their vehicles outside the school gate only.
13. Every call from the school must be given importance with proper implementation.
14. Parents are to visit the Principal and teachers as per the schedule given below:-
  - a. Principal - 11.30am - 12.30 pm and 3.30pm - 4.30pm on all working days  
on emergencies, prior permission is to be taken.
  - b. Teachers - 8am - 10am - every second Saturday (if a working day) in PTM  
Result declaration day as per the notice from school side  
On emergencies, prior permission from the Principal.



## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Candidates desiring to take admission will be required to register themselves by submitting duly filled up registration forms along with registration fees before the last date specified in the advertisement. Incomplete registration forms will stand cancelled.
2. Admission into lower classes will be on the basis of first come first serve basis, subject to availability of seats. If more number of forms received than a lottery may be the criteria for admission.
3. Admission in higher classes will be on the basis of entrance test and availability of seats. (notified about the availability of seats)
4. Depending on the availability of seats in a class, the list of successful candidates along with a waiting list will be put on the notice board of the school after the admission procedure. The student along with the parent will have to appear for an interaction on the date specified.
5. Finally, the selected students will have to deposit the requisite fee within the schedule published, failing which admission will stand cancelled and the waiting list will be updated.

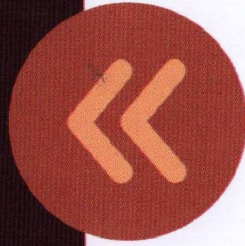

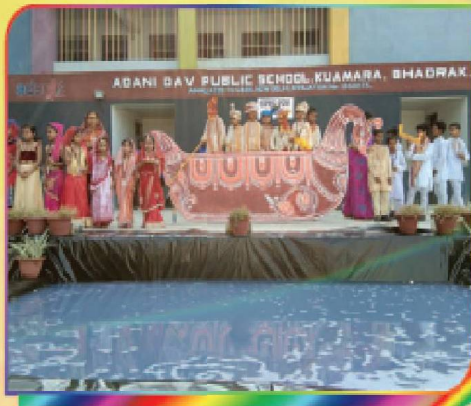
